

7 KEY SCRIPTURES ON HEALING AND PRAYER FOR HEALING

Praise the Lord, my soul, and forget not all his benefits— who forgives all your sins and heals all your diseases. - **Psalm 103:2-3.**

Heal me, Lord, and I will be healed; save me and I will be saved, for you are the one I praise. - **Jeremiah 17:14.**
